

THE COMPETITIONS

CLASS 1 - Nursery Hunter Trials £20

- Limited entries
- Riders must be 12 years or older on the day of the event
- The course will be about 16 fences, approximately 2'6" in height
- The winner to be decided on time

CLASS 2 - Novice Team Competition £36 – Riders 12 & Over

- Team of three riders
- The course will be over the Nursery Hunter Trial course
- All three riders must complete
- The winner to be decided on time
- The class will include a special prize for a Family Team. Phone Secretary for details.

CLASS 3 – Open Hunter Trial £20

- Limited entries
- Riders must be 14 years or older on the day of the event
- Over the Team Event course – suitable for novice horses
- The winner to be decided on time

CLASS 4 – Team Competition £48 - Riders 16 & Over

- Team of four riders.
- The course will have approximately 25 fences
- At least 3 horses and riders must complete the course.
- The time of the third horse to complete will be the time of the team.
- The event will include an Inter-Hunt Competition – all team members competing to be paid up members/subscribers of their Hunt (see special prize below).

PRIZES / TROPHIES

Class 2 –The Donald Trophy for the highest placed team resident in Berwickshire.

CONDITIONS

- The course may be walked from noon Saturday 10th March 2012.
- No horse may be entered in more than one Team or more than one Hunter Trial, or compete in more than two classes.
- All horses must be five years or older.
- Fences must be jumped between the flags – red on the right, white on the left. After three refusals competitors must continue to the next fence.
- Any horse taking the wrong course will be eliminated.
- There will be a maximum time limit.
- Crash helmets and body protectors must be worn.
- The Organisers do not accept any responsibility for any accident, damage or injury to horses, riders, spectators or their property during the period of the entire event.
- 50% of entry money will be refunded if the event is cancelled.
